Founded in **1999**, **Pragati Grameen Vikas Sanstha (PGVS)** is a grassroots development organization working across **Betul, Harda, and Chhindwara districts** of Madhya Pradesh.

PGVS empowers **tribal, Dalit, and marginalized communities** especially **women and youth** to achieve dignity, equality, and self-reliance through education, livelihoods, and participatory governance.

Our approach builds on *community leadership, inclusive institutions, and local knowledge systems* to create sustainable and just rural futures.

OUR VISION & MISSION

Vision:

A society where every person lives with dignity and equality—free from hunger, exploitation, and discrimination.

Mission:

To empower communities and grassroots institutions—especially women—to lead development processes that strengthen livelihoods, education, health, and natural resource management.

OUR THEMATIC FOCUS

- **Child Education & Rights** – quality education and life skills for girls and boys.
- **Women Empowerment & SHGs** – leadership, savings, and income generation.
- **Panchayati Raj & Governance** – strengthening Gram Sabhas and women's participation.
- **Livelihoods & Food Security** – farm and non-farm income improvement.
- **Health & Sanitation** – awareness, maternal health, and nutrition programs.
- **Natural Farming & Environment** – promoting low-cost ecological farming practices.

OUR COMMUNITIES

PGVS works primarily with **Korku and Gond tribal families** and other rural poor in **Bhimpur and Amla blocks**. These are regions of low productivity, high migration, and poor access to services.

Our interventions focus on **enhancing livelihoods, promoting education, and strengthening local governance** especially through women's participation.
